General Membership Meeting (Feb. 9 @ 10:30AM)



Temple Front Fence and Gates Completed

Many of you that have visited the temple have anxiously awaited the completion of the temple front fence and gates. We can finally say that the project has been completed. There are three entry points in the front, looking at the temple from the street: on the right hand side there is the sliding gate (manually open and close), center gate (will be locked at all times except for special occasions), and on the left side (Soto Academy side) have the automatic gate. The automatic gate requires the use of either a remote or key pad to open and close the gate.

Just a reminder that the gates will be open during temple operating hours

however during the hours that the temple is closed, we will be closing the gates for security purposes. This may cause inconvenience but we hope this will help us better maintain proper security from trespassers and keep the temple property from vandalism.

We would like to express our gratitude to everyone for your support and patience as we waited for this project to be completed.
